Day 1 Sun 27 Jul

COPENHAGEN



Welcome to **Copenhagen**, the vibrant capital of Denmark and the land of everyday wonder! Upon arrival, you'll be transferred to your accommodation at the renowned ARP Hansen Phoenix hotel. Enjoy time to explore on your own and stroll through the city's streets. Spend the first evening relaxing and preparing for the incredible journey ahead.

Day 2 Mon 28 Jul COPENHAGEN - At Sea



Start your exploration with a guided sightseeing tour of Copenhagen iconic landmarks. Discover the charm of the Little Mermaid, Gefion Fountain in the Langlin Park, an outside look of Amalienborg Palace including the Royal Guard change if scheduled, photo stop at Nyhavn, a 17thcentury waterfront & canal district, Ströget pedestrian street, the Hans Christian Andersen statue in Radhuspladsen and a visit inside the Christiansborg Palace and the reception rooms. In the afternoon, board an overnight cruise to Oslo, Norway, in a comfortable outside cabin with a sea view. Enjoy dinner on board while watching the sunset over the tranquil waters.

Arrive in Oslo, Norway's capital. Embark on a guided tour of the city's rich heritage. Enter the Fram Polar Ship Museum to delve into the tales of Polar exploration

Day 4 Wed 30 Jul OSLO - HEDDAL - VEMORK - TELEMARK



Journey through the picturesque landscapes, starting with an outside look of the **Heddal Open-Air Museum** and a guided tour of the **Heddal Stave Church**, built in the 13th century and a masterpiece of medieval architecture. Then a guided visit to the **Norwegian Industrial Workers Museum** (UNESCO World Heritage site) in **Vemork** to learn of its historic role during the Second World War. End the day at your charming hotel where you'll enjoy a hearty dinner and rest.

Day 5 Thu 31 Jul TELEMARK – LATEFOSS – HARDANGERFJORD-BERGEN





Today promises for breathtaking natural beauty. Pause for photos at the stunning Latefoss waterfalls before continuing on for a tour and tasting of an apple juice/cider making facility. Cross the serene Hardangerfjord by road ferry via Utne and Kvarndal and arrive at Bergen, for a guided walking tour through the most emblematic places of the city. See Bryggen (UNESCO World Heritage Site), the Hanseatic Wharf, the harbour and the vibrant Fish Market. Finish off to take Fløibanen the funicular railway that offers a scenic ascent to Mount Fløyen, providing breathtaking views of the city, fjords, and surrounding mountains.

Day 6 Fri 1 Aug BERGEN – VOSS – MYRDAL – FLAM - SOGNDAL



Set off from Bergen to **Voss**, where you'll transfer to a scenic train ride to **Myrdal**. Continue the journey with a picturesque train ride to **Flam** on board the famous **Flåmsbana** described by Lonely Planet as one of the best train journeys in the world. Then board road ferry Mannheller -Fodnes to **Sognefjord** to enjoy the stunning fjord landscapes and unwind at your hotel, where dinner awaits.





Day 7 Sat 2 Aug SOGNDAL - FJAERLAND - JOSTEDAL GLACIER - GEIRANGER



The tour continues to **Fjaerland** and view the majestic **Jostedal Glacier** arm with a photo stop to capture its icy splendor. Visit the **Norwegian Glacier Museum** for fascinating insights into glacial history. Head to your hotel in **Geiranger**, where dinner is served against the backdrop of the fjord's breathtaking beauty.

Day 8 Sun 3 Aug GEIRANGER – DALSNIBBA – LOM- LILLEHAMMER

Day 9 Mon 4 Aug

Start the day with a visit to the **Geiranger Skywalk-Dalsnibba**, Europe's highest fjord views from a road at 1,500 metres. Experience a scenic cruise on the **Geiranger Fjord** (UNESCO World Heritage site) passing the famous 7 Sisters waterfall. Stop in **Lom** for a visit at the historic **Stave Church** dating back to 1158, and then in **Lillehammer**, home of the 1994 Winter Olympics. Spend the night at Clarion Collection Hotel Lillehammer, where a delightful dinner awaits.

LILLEHAMMER – FALUN

Begin with a photo stop at Olympic Ski Jump and a guided walking tour of Lillehammer, exploring the **Maihaugen Open-Air Museum,** the largest open-air museum in Norway with close to 200 buildings. Continue the drive via **Nusnäs** to see the traditional Dala horse carving at **Grannas**. Arrive in **Falun**, a historic mining town located in the Dalarna County. Your overnight stay is at the First Hotel Grand, where dinner is included.





Day 10 Tue 5 Aug FALUN – UPPSALA - STOCKHOLM



Continue your journey to **Uppsala**. Stop by **Valsgärde Gravfält** to see a Viking age boat burial grave field. Visit the **Vendel-Vikingage** archeological site in **Gamla** and **Gamla Museum** to see the gigantic burial mounds and learn about Sweden's Viking past. View the outside of the **Uppsala Slott** to hear the story about the castle's history. Stroll at the **Botaniska Garden**, one of Europe's oldest botanical gardens. Outside look at **Uppsala University** Main Building, built in magnificent neoclassical style & Scandinavia's oldest university dating back to 1477. Afterwards, visit the **Uppsala Domkyrka** the largest cathedral in Scandinavia where construction started in 1270s and ended with its inauguration in the year 1435. Head to **Stockholm** and check in the to the Radisson Blu Royal Viking Hotel, where you'll enjoy a relaxing evening.
